Welcome Back! We hope that everyone enjoyed their summer vacation. We know that many students were reading during the summer, and recording their books on a reading log for our "Summer Reading Contest". Please remember to return your reading log to your child's new teacher, so that we can give them their coupons for the draw, which will take place next week at the Cycle Assemblies. If your child is new to the school, then they can still participate in the draw. New parents can **write a note** in their child's agenda indicating the **number of hours** that your child read over the summer. Your child will receive 1 coupon for every 20 minutes that they read. We hope that you are all able to come out to the back to school BBQ on September 1st, 4:00 – 7:00 p.m. It's a great way to meet other parents and staff, and to come together as a school community.

Emergency Procedures: This month we will be practicing emergency procedures with the students. At the 1st Cycle Assembly, the rules for Fire Drills and Lock-Down, Lock-In and Lock-Out will be explained, and students will be told that we will be practicing the procedures. Teachers will practice and prepare the students, and then we will practice the procedures. The firefighters will come later in the month to evaluate us on our performance for a fire drill. For the past several years we have received outstanding feedback from the Fire Chief on our performance, and we plan to continue this trend. "Lock-Out" procedures are similar to a fire drill. They are used in a situation where we might have to evacuate the building for another reason (gas leak, etc.). During a "Lock-Down" drill, students must hide silently in their classroom with a teacher with the door locked, under the pretext that there is a "bad stranger" in the school. "Lock-In" procedures are for a situation where there is an environmental issue outside, and all students must remain/come indoors. If you would like to come and visit to see how we present this topic to students, please feel free to attend a Cycle assembly next week.

Principal Award Assemblies: At the end of each month we will be having Cycle Assemblies where certain children will be receiving an award for their great work. If your child is the recipient, you will receive an invitation to attend the assembly.
