GOVERNING BOARD NEWS!

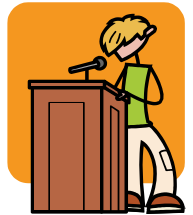


The Governing Board recently reviewed the WQSB policy on “Educational Services for Students with Special Needs”. Last year we expressed our concern to the WQSB that “gifted” students were not identified as having special needs under this policy. Unfortunately, the School Board policy is unable to identify gifted students because they do not fall in the Ministry’s definition of “Special Needs”. Although we are fortunate that Lord Aylmer staff make great efforts to accommodate the needs of these students, we believe these needs should also be acknowledged by the WQSB at a policy level. In our last meeting we also continued our discussions regarding the breakdown of French/English instruction across cycles. We were pleased to learn that, aside from minor discrepancies, Aylmer schools are generally quite synchronized in this regard. As such, when students reach Symmes, it is difficult to distinguish between children from the various feeder schools in regard to their language competence.
