TRIBES TIP

Now that June has arrived, this will be our last Tribes Tip before the summer holidays. Sometimes your child may report that "they are bored and have nothing to do". Try the "Snowball" strategy to help your children come up with activities to do throughout the day. Give each person a piece of paper and a pencil. First, they are to write or draw somewhere at home or within walking distance where they would like to play. Scrunch up the pieces of paper into balls and throw them in a box. Each person then grabs someone else's piece of paper from the box. Draw or write what you would like to do at this location. GOVERNING BOARD NEWS

The last meeting of the Governing Board was a busy one. We were updated about the decision by the WQSB Parent Committee to disaffiliate from the Fédération des comités de parents du Québec (FCPQ). This has been discussed for some time at the Parent Committee level. The decision was made essentially given that English School Boards did not feel adequately represented (i.e. issues relevant to English Boards only were given less consideration than issues relevant to the significant French Board majority). Suzanne Gorman (our representative on the Parent Committee) represented Lord Aylmer's interests well in this rather heated debate, and our thanks go to her. At our last Governing Board meeting we reviewed our voting policy. We also approved a change to the process for obtaining school supplies at the Junior Campus. Finally, we reviewed the terms of office of our current members. As such, we are aware that we will have 4 vacant positions next year on the Governing Board. We would like to encourage all parents to consider donating their time and talents in this capacity. Membership on the Governing Board is a rewarding and informative experience that allows us as parents to influence school policy. 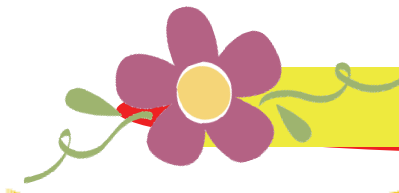
Lord Aylmer finalists will compete at the WQSB Track & Field day on June 11th at Philemon Wright High School. Good luck everyone!



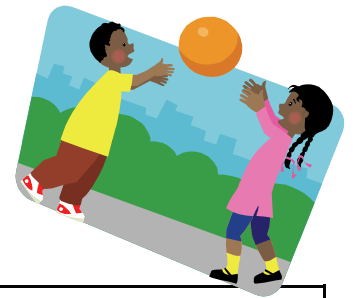
Volunteer Tea

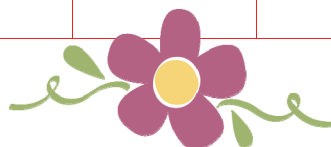
