Students at the Jr. Campus will be charged \$35 for school supplies.

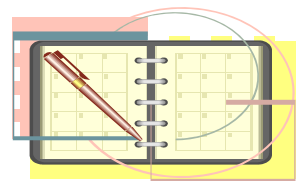
BUS ACCOMODATION
