Principal's Message



The school year has been quite successful to date. We are proud to say that students are doing a great job at following the Tribes Agreements, which creates a safe and caring environment.

What is the Tribes program, and what does it mean to be a Tribes School? Teachers and Day-care received a four day training, wherein they learned strategies to help build Inclusion (developing a sense of belonging); Influence (learning to value differences in others and manage conflict) and Community (learning to work cooperatively together as a team). Staff members model the four Tribes Agreements daily, so that students will learn to respect one another, give appreciation statements, listen attentively, and participate in the classroom and in the schoolyard. Students have the "Right to Pass" if they do not feel comfortable participating in a certain activity.

In the classroom, students earn Tribes tickets. Once they have earned all four tickets (one for each agreement), their name is posted on a star on our Tribes bulletin board. Stars are sent home at the end of each term. If they earn seven stars in a year, their name is painted on a ceiling tile on our "Tribes Walk of Fame".

During recesses and lunch hour, students earn coloured popsicle sticks for following the Agreements. We are proud to say that each campus has already filled the Tribes popsicle stick bucket once and has earned a reward.

We will be sending home Tribes Tips in each newsletter, for parents who wish to use some strategies at home. We will hold a Tribes parent information session one evening in early December. More information to follow.
