Eggless Cake Recipe:

CAKE : 1 cup brown sugar, 2 cups flour, 1 teaspoon baking soda, 1 teaspoon cinnamon
1/2 cup of Crisco vegetable grease, 2 cups of either mashed bananas or apple sauce (I used apple sauce)

- Bake at 350 degrees for about 20-24 minutes.

1 Brick of Crisco

1 bag 1kg Icing Sugar

1 tsp of vanilla extract

Optional: You may also add 1 tsp of butter, ~~and 1 tsp of meringue powder~~
